FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS THE STORY OF DRACULA A MYTH?

You will visit Dracula's Castle, know as Bran Castle, and experience Transylvania rich heritage to discover if Dracula is a myth or a legend.

WHY SHOULD I CHOSE ROMANIA?

Located in the Eastern part of Europe, Romania is a member of the European Union. Despite the rapid economic development, the country is facing major depopulation, second highest emigration growth rate after Syria caused by deteriorating socio-economic factors, that impacts mostly rural areas and affects mainly the young population. For these reasons there is a strong need to accelerate entrepreneurial and social initiatives to improve the well-being. Romania is also home to some of Europe's oldest traditions, history and customs which will be introduced to you by hospitable locals.

CAN I REALLY ACHIEVE ANYTHING IN JUST 12 DAYS?

In short, yes. You will work with a local team who understands needs and priorities. You will help design social innovations and work on short-term consulting projects leaving frameworks for success for local leaders.

WHAT KIND OF WORK WILL I DO?

Community Consulting with Romanian Business Leader Foundation - www.rbls.ro and Dolhesti local organizations. RBL is a community of professionals, entrepreneurs, and Romanian managers with a diverse background. RBL recently started a new initiatives called "Antreprenoresti" which aims to develop social entrepreneurial initiative in Romanian villages to improve the well-being of the community members. You will first meet with RBL leadership in Bucharest and have strategic conversations about their needs and wants. The second phase is to travel and work in Dolhesti with local organizations and community leaders.

Social Innovation with Change Architects is a strategic educational initiative of AllGrow, which transforms 8 to 18 years old students into Changemakers through community development and social entrepreneurship. You will engage in social innovation design activities with AllGrow and potentially support the preparation and implementation of Change Architects Summer Innovation Camp. The Camps are organized at a new location every year and 5 top Change Architects teams are selected based on their project performance to participate.

WHO IS LEADING THIS?

The trip is led by Madalina Bouros the founder of AllGrow a local Romanian organization and is endorsed by Social Entrepreneur Corps. Madalina has led programs with Social Entrepreneur Corps in Latin America for over 6 years.

IS IT SAFE?

Romania is part of the European Union and is a safe country to visit.
